Second class first aid—17th, 28th and 28th. First class first aid—65th, 28th and 28th. Second class signalling—28th, 17th and 65th. First class signalling—17th, 28th and 3rd. Scout tug-of-war—3rd, 65th and 17th. Cub knots—3rd, 17th and 3rd. Stepping-stones—3rd, 17th and 65th. Skin-the-snake—3rd, 65th and 12th. Cub tug-o'-war—3rd, 65th and 17th.
